

Directions from Bethany to HKG International Airport

There are a few routes you can take from Bethany to HKG International Airport, depending on your schedule, budget and number of travelers.

The most straightforward and convenient are to go via Hong Kong Island/ Central:

Firstly take the ferry from Cheung Chau to Central.

The ordinary ferry takes 50 minutes and costs \$13.20 (\$19.40 on Sundays & Public Hols), the fast ferry takes 35 minutes and costs \$25.80 (\$37.20 on Sundays & Public Hols).

Then you have 2 options:

1 – via Airport Express (most convenient, but not cheapest at \$90-100!):

- Exit the ferry pier at Central, turn right and head down to Pier 3 (Discover Bay)
- Go up the escalator and on to the elevated walkway in to the IFC Mall
- Follow signs for 'Hong Kong Station/ In-town Check-in' (*approx 10 minutes walk*)
- You will go down escalator to the airport-style check-in area, where you can check your luggage in like at the airport (it is often quicker than doing so at the airport) – you will be issued boarding-pass, your luggage is now checked-through to final destination (unless requiring change of airlines en route, which check-in staff will advise you if necessary)
- Then take the airport express (\$90-100) to Hong Kong International Airport – journey time 26-28 minutes, with only 2 stops along the way.
- On arrival at HKG airport, exit the train *to the left*, proceed through security and to your boarding gate.

2 – via Bus A11 or E11 (\$40 & \$21 respectively)

- Exit the ferry pier at Central, turn left and walk down to the Pier 7/ Star Ferry then up onto the overhead walkway.
- Walk towards Central MTR station, which is signposted along the walkway. When you get to the escalator from the walkway go down but then instead of going into the MTR station (on your left), proceed straight on towards the bus stops.
- You will pass an 'MX' restaurant, then just before the McDonalds there are bus stops for Airport Bus A11 (journey approx 40 mins cost \$40) or E11 (journey approx 75 minutes cost \$21)

On arrival at HKG airport, follow the signs to go up in elevator to departures/ check-in.

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Alternative & more scenic route:

If you are not in a hurry, then we might recommend traveling to HKG airport via the Lantau/ Mui Wo route. This involves taking the inter-island ferry from Cheung Chau to Mui Wo (Lantau island).

There are only 10 ferries per day on this route though, so it really is only an option if you can schedule it for your particular situation (*ask our staff for a ferry timetable and advice if unsure*). The ferry to Mui Wo takes approx 40 minutes and costs \$12.80 (no difference on Sunday/ Public Hols).

On arrival at Mui Wo ferry pier you have 3 options to get to airport:

1. Take a taxi (blue) – this would be most cost-effective for a family of for 2-4 people traveling together – approx \$150 one-way and certainly the quickest + it would drop you at departure level at airport.
2. Take the airport bus/ coach A35 / N35 – cost \$15 (\$25 on Sunday & Public Hols) / \$21 (\$32 on Sunday & Public Hols) with journey time up to 60 minutes to the HKG airport. These only operate a few times per day though, with departures from Mui Wo of the A35 bus at 5.35am, 7.30am, 5.10pm, 10pm or 00.15am, the N35 departs Mui Wo at 3.15am or 4.10am. So again you would need to carefully plan the route to your flight.
Several guests have found that taking the 6.35am Inter-Island ferry from Cheung Chau to Mui Wo arrives at around 7am, which gives enough time to connect on to the A35 bus departing at 7.30am.
3. Take Bus 3M to Tung Chung bus interchange – cost \$10.50 (\$16.20 on Sunday/ Public Hols) and approx 30 mins. At Tung Chung, change on to the shuttle bus S1 or S56 going to HKG airport & ASIA World Expo – cost \$3.5 or \$3.6 with journey approx 15 mins to airport.

On arrival at HKG airport, follow signs to departures/ check-in (go up on elevator or walk-way).
